



## SHAWNEE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH COMMUNITY GARDEN REGULATIONS

1. All garden plots must be kept free of weeds and trash during the garden season (March thru November).
2. Plants should be planted at least 1.5 ft. from all sides of your garden plot.
2. All trash (paper, plastic, etc.) must be placed in the dumpster or taken home.
3. All unwanted plant residue, weeds or other organic matter can be placed in the compost area.
4. No permanent structures (fences, raised beds, benches) may be erected around or in your garden plot. Chicken wire around plants, tomato cages, trellises, etc. that can be removed at the end of the season are permitted.
5. A water spigot with a hose is available. Please use water responsibly. Make sure water is turned off and the padlock is locked when you are done watering.
6. Use only insecticides and fungicides that appear on the approved list. Follow directions on the labels.
7. **No herbicides** (chemical weed killers or preventatives) may be used in the garden.
8. **No pets** are allowed in the community garden area.
9. **No illegal** plants may be grown in the garden plots.
10. Leaves will be available for mulch. Carpet or tar paper may not be used for mulch.

11. If you are unable to tend your garden for an extended period of time due to illness, injury or other reasons, please notify the Church office 631-6689.
12. Complaints, suggestions or questions should be made in writing and left In the church office for the committee.
13. You are not permitted to be in other person's garden plots and may not pick produce or plants from other garden plots unless you have obtained permission.
14. You are responsible for any visitors that you bring to the garden and their actions/behavior while visiting.
15. Any incidents of vandalism or theft should be reported to Shawnee Presbyterian Church office 631-6689.
