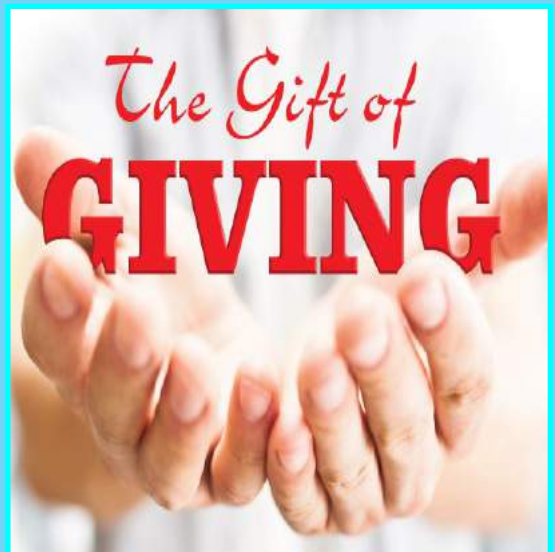
Food When We're Fed

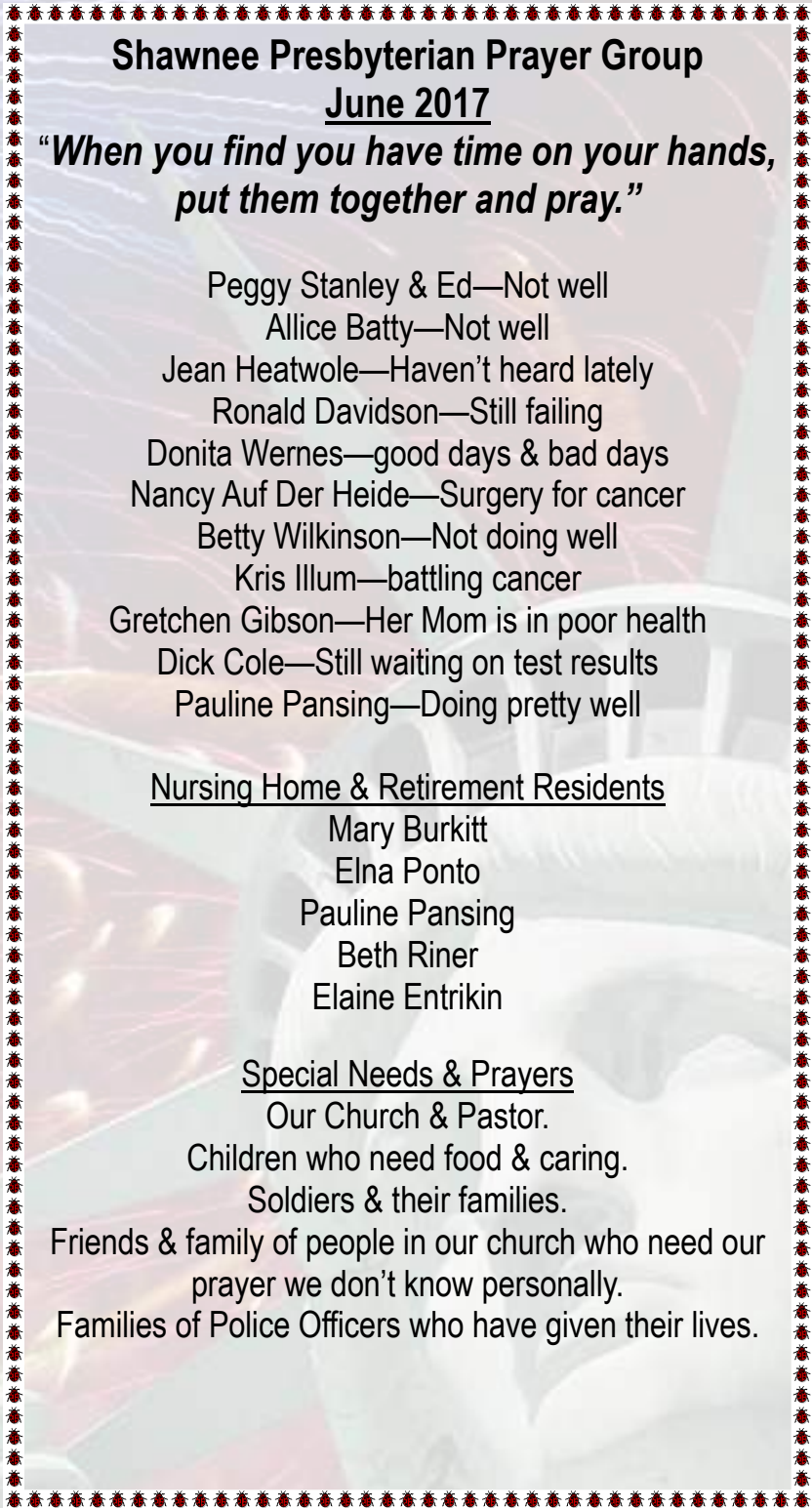
